## Silver Lake Township Regular Meeting Monday June 6, 2016

Francis Fruehan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and called for a salute to the Flag.

Minutes from the May meeting were read and approved with corrections on a motion made by Evan Everitt and seconded by Butch DeLousia, approved.

The Treasurer report was read, approved and held for audit on a motion made by Evan Everitt and seconded by Butch DeLousia, approved.

Public Comment: Angel Kublo asked about a check drawn from the Police Fund. Francis Fruehan explained as per the budget this check will go into a savings account for the purchase of a police when needed.

A resident spoke regarding problems with individuals riding four-wheelers and dirt bikes on the roads. Sometimes there are as many as 8 to 10 on the road and are very loud. He expressed concern with accidents.

Another resident had a similar problem on Heavey Road. He video taped them, they ended up coming back and apologizing.

Evan Everitt reviewed the bids received at the April meeting. Schoenberger has awarded the bid for dust control at the April meeting. The bids for fuels has been reviewed. Evan Everitt made a motion to approved WOC Energy for all fuels – gasoline at \$1.669, Diesel at \$1.5526 and heating oil at \$1.415, Butch DeLousia seconded, approved.

Evan Everitt has a payoff figure from Peoples Security and Trust Bank for the building loan in the amount of \$2,198.51. It was explained that the township millage had been shifted so the building could be paid off early. With this payment the loan will be paid in full and millage will be adjusted back with the next budget.

Francis Fruehan explained an line item had been inadvertently left off the Police Budget. Resolution 2016-1 was read to amend the police budget by adding account number 410.26 for Police Education and Training. The amended budget will be posted on the township website.

Francis Fruehan read the police report with 20 incidents for the month of May. The full report will be posted on the bulletin board after the meeting and will also run in the local newspapers.

Evan Everitt gave the road report. Township has been awarded a Dirt/Gravel Road Project for Snow Hollow Road. The Pop's Hobby Road project has started. A resident asked about Barney Road. Evan Everitt explained that Barney Road needs to be built up and said he is having problems with residents on the road putting their yard waste in the ditches which has caused drainage problems.
