Francis Fruehan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and called for a pledge to the Flag.

Minutes from the September meeting were read and approved on a motion made by Evan Everitt and seconded by Butch DeLousia, all approved.

Treasurer Report was read, approved and held for audit on a motion made by Evan Everitt and seconded by Butch DeLousia, all approved.

Public Comment: Earl Lesch expressed concerns with 4-wheelers on the road. The Supervisors recommended Mr. Lesch to contact the Silver Lake Police Department.

Old/New Business: Francis Fruehan discussed putting up a 60' X 60' unheated p9ole building on the township property just up the hill. The old cold storage building behind the municipal building has a lot of problems and would be torn down. Mr. Fruehan said he is working on putting a specification packet together so it can hopefully be put out to bid at the next meeting to see what comes in.

Francis Fruehan said the township is looking into starting a 401a Retirement Plan for township employees. This is a defined contribution system for IPA municipal employees similar to a 401k plan. The township currently has no retirement plan for any employees. The Pennsylvania Association of Township Supervisors has prepared a sample request for proposal for administration of the 401a retirement plan that will need to be advertised it the paper.

Mr. Fruehan asked for questions or comments. A resident said it was a good idea. Francis Fruehan made a motion to advertise for proposals for the 401a Plan, Butch DeLousia seconded, approved.

Francis Fruehan said 2018 budget work sessions have been advertised but would like to add a few more work sessions for Wednesday – October 18 and October 25 at 7:00 pm at the township building. Hopefully the 2018 budget will be ready for presenting at the November meeting and will be adopted at the December meeting. Francis Fruehan made a motion to advertise the additional work sessions, Butch DeLousia seconded, all approved.

Francis Fruehan read the police report — there were 12 incidents plus 11 traffic stops for the month of September.

Evan Everitt gave the road report. Barney Road has been tar/chipped. Getting equipment ready for winter.
