

Silver Lake Township  
Regular Meeting  
May 1, 2017

Francis Fruehan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and called for a salute to the Flag.

The minutes from the April meeting were read and approved on a motion made by Evan Everitt and seconded by Butch DeLousia, all approved.

The Treasurer's report was read, approved and held for audit on a motion made by Evan Everitt and seconded by Butch DeLousia, all approved.

Public Comment: Ron Regan delivered a letter to the Supervisors prior to the meeting from the Silver Lake Rescue Squad requesting money from the Act 13 funds for the purchase of a new stretcher. Members of the square are getting older and a powered lift stretcher is a great help. The total cost of the stretcher is \$13,000. Ron Regan said they would like \$ 7,661.68. They would also be asking Choconut Township Supervisors for a donation as well. Francis Fruehan said it would be considered once Act 13 funds received in July. Francis Fruehan explained how the Act 13 Funds were handled and said each the amount received has declined over the last couple of years.

Evan Everitt opened bids received for the sluice pipes that were rebid:

Marie Turner Inc.: 6" \$1.65/ft. and \$2.75 per collar  
15" \$5.72/ft. and \$9.59 per collar  
18" \$8.70/ft. and \$17.04 per collar  
24" \$13.50/ft. and \$23.43 per collar

However, the bid says the prices are good for 30 days only and the bid form states must be for the full year.

Bradco Supply: 6" \$1.04/ft.  
15" \$6.30/ft. and \$7.91 per collar  
18" \$8.91/ft. and \$11.18 per collar  
24" \$14.50/ft. and \$18.20 per collar

Evan Everitt made a motion to table awarding the sluice pipes until June, Butch DeLousia seconded, all approved.

Francis Fruehan read the police report with 5 incidents for the month of April plus 14 traffic stops.

Evan Everitt gave the road report. Application for a Dirt/Gravel Road Project on Brittan has been submitted and he should know next month if it has been approved. John Demaree asked what the plan was for the repair of Barney Road.

Evan Everitt explained he planned on putting millings on the road and then tar and chip. There are a number of driveways that are causing issues on the road as well as residents on Barney Road putting their yard waste in the ditches. Ron Reagan asked about repair Lower Rhiney Creek Road. Evan Everitt said they have tried working on it but the frost is still coming out of the ground.

Driveway permits – none

Butch DeLousia made a motion to approve the bills as submitted, Evan Everitt seconded, all approved.

As no further business was presented, Butch DeLousia made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Evan Everitt seconded, all approved.
