October 1, 2018

Francis Fruehan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and called for a salute to the Flag.

The minutes from the September meeting were read and approved on a motion made by Evan Everitt and seconded by Butch DeLousia, all approved.

The treasurer report was read, approved and held for audit on a motion made by Evan Everitt and seconded by Butch DeLousia, all approved.

Public Comment: Sylvia Tokos questioned a building permit for a dock and a proposed new house at Quaker Lake. Francis Fruehan said he was not aware of any building permits for a house at that location and that dock permits are handled by Susquehanna County Soil Conservation Service. Mrs. Tokos wanted it noted that she is protesting the neighbors building a house or dock house at Quaker Lake. It was her understanding that if a residence had never been built on a lot on the lakefront, then it could not be built on. Francis Fruehan said he was not aware of any such ordinance or regulation.

A resident asked how much longer Pops Hobby Lake Road would be closed. Evan Everitt said he has checked on the project and the new pipe is not in yet.

There are now signs up for a detour for the closure of SR 167 that has been down to one lane. That project should be started soon.

PennDOT is bringing in road crews from other counties for 12 days to assist Susquehanna County with getting the damaged roads repaired.

Francis Fruehan said the franchise agreement with Zito Media is not ready to be signed yet.

Evan Everitt made a motion to advertise on Auctions International the following equipment: 1991 BMY Cargo Truck, 10K Diesel Generator, 1985 Army Pickup Truck, Miscellaneous Tires and Tire Chains, Butch DeLousia seconded, all approved.

Evan Everitt said the John C McNamara road project has been put on hold.

Francis Fruehan said it is time to begin working on the 2019 Budget and made a motion to advertise for work sessions will be held on 10/8/18, 10/15/18, 10/22/18, 10/25/18 and 10/29/18, for the proposed 2019 budget to be presented at the November meeting and for Budget adoption at the December meeting, Evan Everitt seconded, all approved.

Francis Fruehan read the police report with 8 incidents and 7 traffic stops for the month of September.

Butch DeLousia made a motion to approve the bills as submitted, Evan Everitt seconded, all approved.
