Silver Lake Township August 6, 2018

Francis Fruehan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and called for a salute to the Flag.

The minutes from the July meeting were read and approved on a motion made by Evan Everitt and seconded by Butch DeLousia, all approved

The Treasurer Report was read, approved and held for audit on a motion made by Evan Everitt and seconded by Butch DeLousia, all approved.

Francis spoke on the bid received for the road project on John C McNamara Drive. Even Everitt summarized the project which is approximately 1.3 miles (6,950 feet) and would start at SR 167 and end at the bottom of the hill just past the township building. The last time the road was paved was in 2005. This project could be funded with State Funds or Act 13 Funds. Evan Everitt made a motion to accept the bid received from Northeast Lime and Stone, Butch DeLousia seconded, all approved.

A resident asked about the road repair on SR 167. Evan Everitt said he has talked to PennDOT and was told and project was to be started between July 2018 and October 2018. Hopefully the project will be started soon.

Act 13 Funds received in July in the amount of \$258,351.31. These funds were deposited into the Act 13 Holding Account. After funds have been distributed as scheduled, the balance will be transferred into the Act 13 Capital Reserve Account.

Francis Fruehan read the Police Report for June – 11 incidents and 10 traffic stops; July 11 incidents and 27 traffic stops.

Assessment Permits – one for Sally Wash for a garage on Laurel Lake.

Driveway Permits – None.

Evan Everitt gave the road report. All township roads have been completed once. Brittain Road Dirt and Gravel Road Project about complete.

Freightliner truck/tractor has been purchased from Ohio. Truck has 2,000 miles on it. All the fluids have been trained from the truck. Evan Everitt explained that once they have a chance to work on the truck it will be decided if it will be used for a plow truck or a parts truck.

Butch DeLousia made a motion to pay the bills as submitted, Evan Everitt seconded, all approved.

As no further business was presented, Francis Fruehan made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Evan Everitt seconded, all approved.
