Regular Monthly Meeting  
July 5, 2022

Francis Fruehan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and called for a salute to the flag.

Minutes from the June regular monthly meeting were read and approved on a motion made by Evan Everitt and seconded by Francis Fruehan, approved.

The Treasurer report was read, approved and held for audit on a motion made by Evan Everitt and seconded by Francis Fruehan, approved.

Public Comment: None

Evan Everitt reviewed the bids received on the 2021 GMC pickup truck advertised on Auctions International. The high bid was \$47,600.00. Evan Everitt made a motion to accept the high bid of \$47,600.00 received, Francis Fruehan seconded, approved. The funds will go back into the equipment fund.

Evan Everitt reviewed the bids received for the 10 kw military diesel generator that was advertised for bids on Auctions International. The high bid received was \$14,50.00. Evan Everitt made a motion to accept the high bid, Francis Fruehan seconded, approved.

Evan Everitt reviewed phone quotes received for the 24 KW generator --- \$13,750, \$15,250.00 and \$16,250. He explained the township would be responsible for the propane tank as well as the moving the overhead line to an underground installation. Evan Everitt made a motion to approve the bid received from Jim Histan General Construction in Rome, PA for \$13,750, Francis Fruehan seconded, approved.

Francis Fruehan received documents from PSATS regarding IRS requirements to update the 401A Plan for full-time township employees. The documents will be reviewed and should be ready for adoption at the August meeting.

The Act 13 check has been received from the state in the amount of \$281,176,78. This is an increase of \$160,537.66 over last year. This check was deposited in the Act 13 Holding Account

Francis Fruehan read the police report with two incidents plus three traffic stops for the month of June.

Evan Everitt gave the road report – working township roads, Kelly Road project should be started in July.
